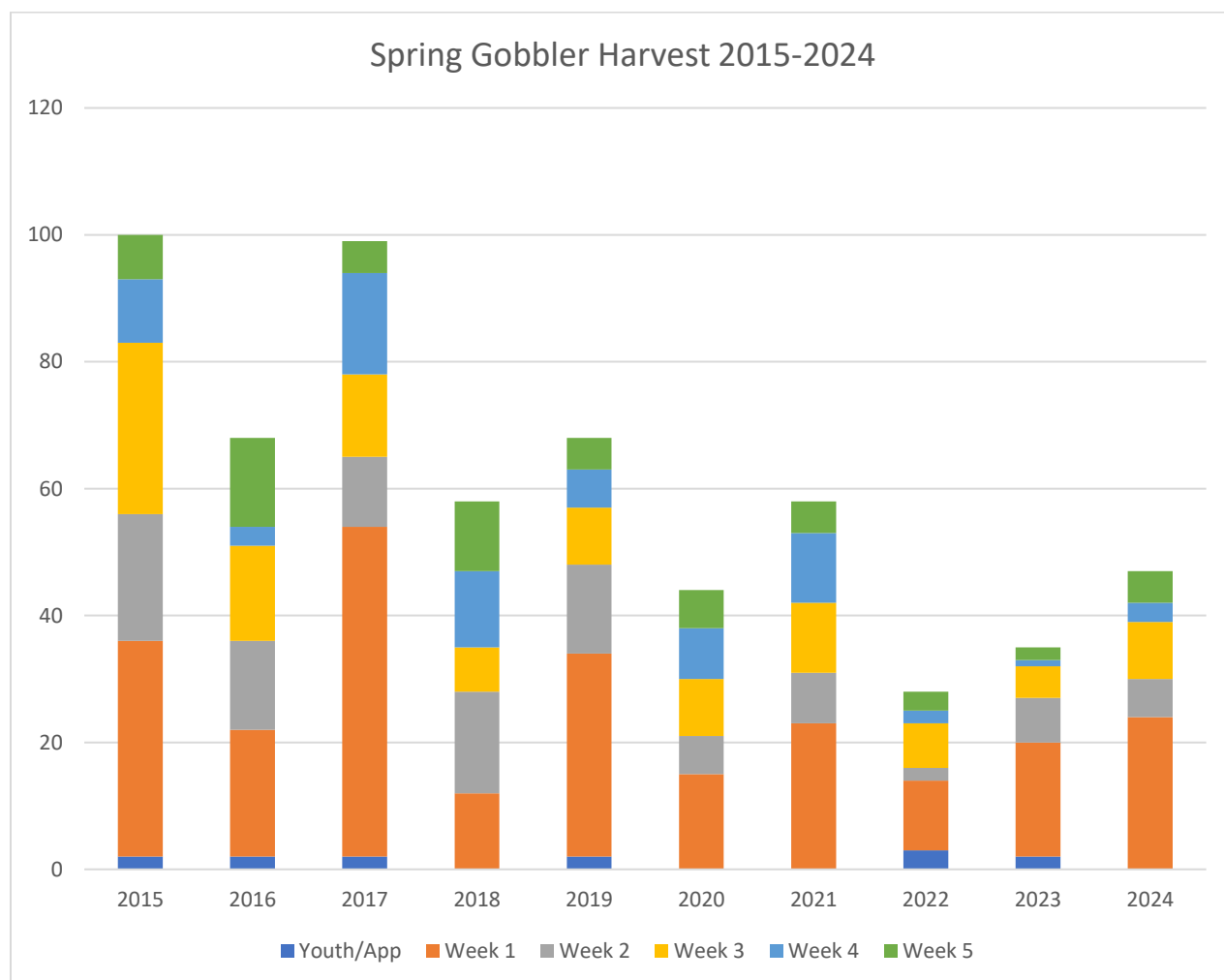


Figure 1. Spring Turkey Harvest Totals (includes bearded hens)

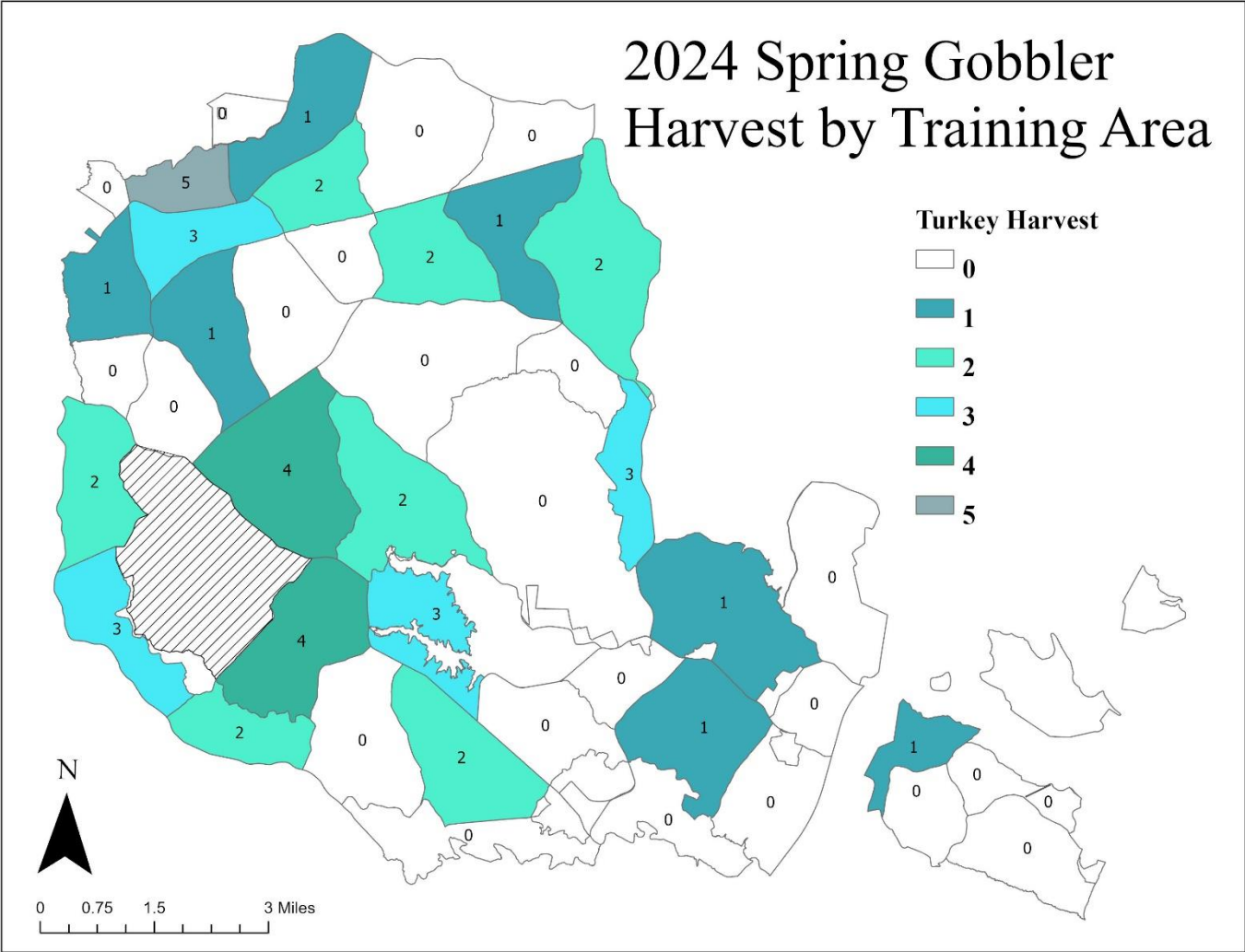


Figure 2. Spring Gobbler Harvest on MCBQ by Training Area
