Conservation Volunteer Program: Procedures

Application

- 1. Prior to volunteering, a Conservation Volunteer Program (CVP) application must be submitted.
- 2. Applications can be found on the <u>Quantico iSportsman</u> website. Applications can be submitted to <u>aantram@vt.edu</u>.
- 3. Applications will be reviewed and then submitted for approval by Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs (NREA) administration.
- 4. Volunteer applicants must create or already have a Quantico iSportsman account.
- 5. Applicants will be notified when their application is approved and they are cleared to participate in volunteer activities
- 6. A "Conservation Volunteer Permit" will be added to the volunteer's iSportsman account after application is approved

Volunteering

<u>ALL</u> volunteer activities must be approved or assigned by the Head of Fish and Wildlife (Mr. Shannon Bowling) or Conservation Volunteer Program Coordinator (Alex Antram) prior to their execution.

- 1. Volunteers will check in and out of Base and their volunteer activities using the Quantico iSportsman webpage
- 2. Refer to the <u>Quantico iSportsman Checkin/Checkout Process User Guide</u> for step by step instructions
- 3. CVP Checkin Details
 - a. On the "Select Activity" page, choose "Conservation Volunteer Activity"
 - b. On the "Select Area" page, choose "Conservation Volunteer Program"
- 4. CVP Checkout Details
 - a. Select "Conservation Volunteer Program Checkout"
 - b. Select appropriate activity, work hours, and TAs

Volunteers who do not abide by these procedures and guidelines may be removed from the program. Volunteers 14-17 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who also needs to complete the application process and utilize the Quantico iSportman web page for recording volunteer activities on Base.
